Functions of Substance Abuse

- × Sense of control
- × Re-connection to people
- × Sooth pain
- × Relax



Substance Abuse & Trauma The question isn't: Why the substance abuse? The questions is:

Why the pain?

Absolutely anything can become an addiction. It's not the external behaviors – it's our relationship to it.

Risks of Substance Abuse

- More likely to be blamed by others – decrease in personal & professional support
- × Not seen as credible or reliable
- Compromised cognitive functioning which impairs safety planning & crisis response.



Limitations of 'Sobriety First'

May be unwilling to trade substance for safety.

Many substance abuse agencies don't have Sexual Assault training. People who cause harm may actively sabotage sobriety.



Treatment Options

× **Abstinence** – What social issues stress abstinence?

× Harm Reduction – What is harm reduction?
